Subject: 2026 Commonwealth Kho Kho Championships

I am pleased to confirm the Commonwealth Sport, Sports Committee has provided approval for the sanctioning of the 2026 Commonwealth Kho Kho Championships, which will take place in India between 9 – 14 March 2026. This approval has been made in line with the attached Commonwealth Sport Championships Policy and subject to the following additional requirements:

- Confirmation that the International Kho Kho Federation has a Safeguarding Policy and an appropriate Safeguarding Plan for the event. Both of these shall be available for Commonwealth Sport to consider, upon request.
- Detailed entry information is provided in due course, that demonstrates the event has met the expected target number of competitors from a range of Commonwealth countries.
- Approval is for the dates listed above only.
- At the conclusion of the competition, Commonwealth Sport requires you to submit a report on the Championships, including the final entries and results.

Please note the following, in line with the attached policy:

- Commonwealth Sport will contribute up to 50% of the cost of medals for the event, to a maximum of £2,000. This is subject to Commonwealth Sport's approval of the design and inclusion of the Commonwealth Sport "Endorsed Event" logo on the medal ribbon, in accordance with the Endorsed Event Logo Guidelines that were shared with you on 08 October 2025. Please note, Commonwealth Sport is unable to commit any additional funding over and above this amount.
- We also encourage the use of Commonwealth Sport branding (using the "Endorsed Event" logo") at sanctioned Commonwealth Championships. Should you wish to do this, approval must be gained from Commonwealth Sport on the use of the logo prior to production of any material.
